Please make sure that you have all the parts indicated before you begin assembly of this item.

Please read Wiring Instructions before you begin assembly and installing your Chandelier.

WARNING: BEFORE INSTALLING Make sure electricity supply is shut off to avoid a possible electric shock.

Assembly Instructions

- Carefully remove the parts and hardware from the carton.
- Fasten the Cross Bar(C)to the outlet box using the Outlet box Screws(D).
- Insert the shorter end of the Pre-Threaded Pipe(E)into the pre-drilled hole in the Cross Bar(C)and secure with the Hex Nut(F).See Illustration.
- Attach the Collar loop (H)to the exposed end of the Pre-Threaded Pipe(E)and secure by turning in a clockwise direction.
- Slip the Pre-Threaded Ring(G)first and then the Canopy(I)over the other end of the Chain(K),
- Attach the Quick Link (L) to two bitter end of the Chain (K).
- Attach the Quick Link on one end of the Chain to Collar loop(H).
- Attach the Quick Link(L)on other end of the chain (K) to the loop of the chandelier Assembly.
- Lace the wire through every link of the chain,through the collar and up through the Pre-Threaded Pipe(E).See Illustration.




Figure 2 - Wire Nut

- Place the white,ribbed or tinted wire evenly against the white wire from the outlet box and place the black,smooth or un-tinted wire evenly against the black wire from the outlet box.(Connecting the Wire -See Figure2)
- Install the ground wire in the Cross Bar with the green screw supplied.
- After the wires are connected,tuck them carefully inside the outlet box.Place Canopy(I)over the outlet box and secure with Pre-Threaded Ring(G).
- Attach the Glass(B)onto the socket of Chandelier Assembly(A)and secure by turning in a clockwise direction.See Illustration.
- Install 100 Watt,Type A bulbs(sold separately)into the sockets of the fixture.

CLEANING: This item has a lacquered and baked finish. When cleaning only use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleansers or abrasives as they may damage the finish.


